Designer Audrey Scheck revamps her own home with an ubercool kitchen and movie room combo perfect for entertaining.

Designer Audrey Scheck's (audreyscheckdesign.com) Austin abode is a hub for entertaining. The newly built 4,000-square-foot space boasts four bedrooms, four bathrooms and plenty of top-tier amenities, particularly the skillfully designed kitchen and movie room. Scheck's dream design? "The goal was to add more character and personal style while keeping it functional for the family of four," her team explains. They started by removing and donating all of the builder-grade fixtures, including all lighting, plumbing, flooring and hardware, replacing them with timeless, organic pieces that more closely fit the family's aesthetic.

The kitchen is rife with well-layered wood tones, an organic nod to nature that adds texture and intrigue. Dunn Edwards paint in Shady adds an eye-catching element to the cabinets, paired with Lostine pendant lighting and honed Calacatta Chiara marble countertops to complete the airy environs.

The movie room sports a decidedly darker vibe with custom dark blue paint by Sherwin Williams and varied seating from Pottery Barn. Overall? We think these rooms are entertaining goals. ■
