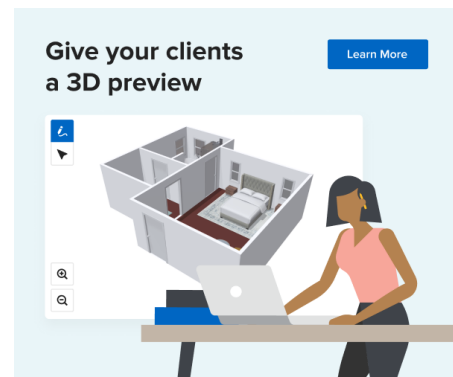
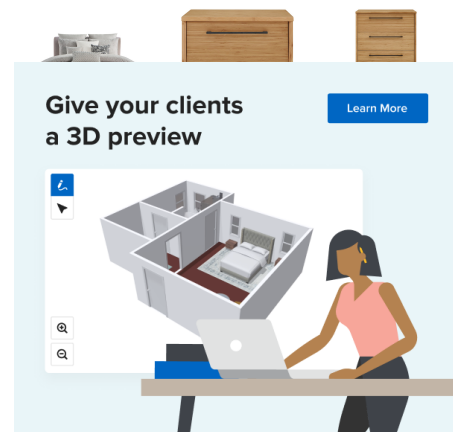
10. Natural Beauty

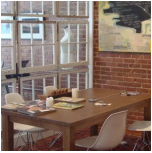

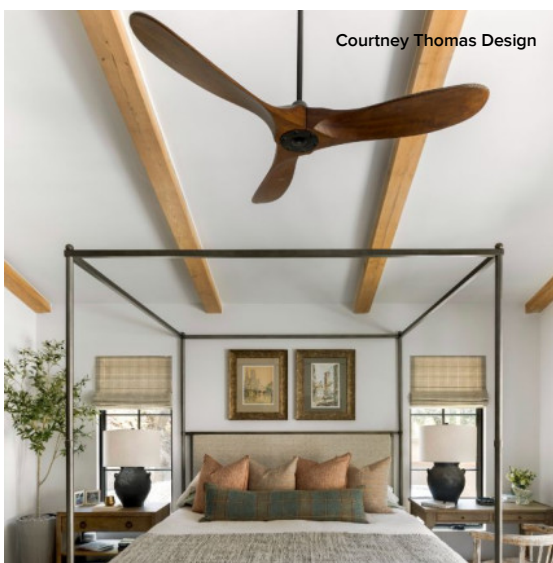
impressively coordinated artwork-and-pillow pairing pop against the pale backdrop.

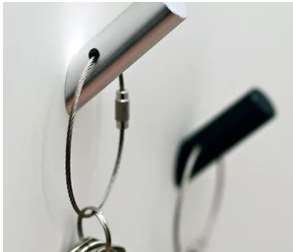
